

HOPPER TRAFFIC ALARM

Activate the battery in your Hopper device by pulling out the snippet.



Press the button for 3 seconds to turn it on/off. It is not necessary to turn off the device during regular use.

AUTO START/STOP

If the Hopper traffic alarm is on, it automatically connects to the app when the car is in motion.

MOUNT IN THE CAR


It is unnecessary to place the Hopper device in the windshield of the car. Instead, place it somewhere within reach, where it does not impair the driver's view.

Hopper recommends to use a phone holder when using the app in order to maintain traffic safety.



CONNECT APP & TRAFFIC ALARM

1. Turn on your Hopper Traffic alarm by holding the button for 3 seconds until you hear a sound.
2. Turn your phone's Bluetooth on. Note: Hopper will not appear on the Bluetooth list.
3. Open the Hopper app.
4. Go to the device connection page in the app and follow the instructions on screen.





SOUNDS & SPOKEN ALERTS

Keep your eyes on the road and hands on the wheel. The Hopper app delivers spoken warnings in various situations. The audio output can be defined in the audio settings in the app.

Hopper can be toggled to output audio through 3 channels: Bluetooth, Media or Mobile.

AUDIO VIA BLUETOOTH

All audio will be played via the car's stereo system, interrupting both radio and streamed media / music playback.

NB! On some car stereo systems, if an interruption occurs while listening to the radio, it may appear as an active phone call - this is not the case.

AUDIO VIA MEDIA

All audio output will be played via the car's stereo system, interrupting only streamed media / music playback.

AUDIO VIA MOBILE

Audio is only played through the phone's speaker.
